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| English | <p>Regular revision tasks set and practice essays written in class. Revision sessions in English lessons during study leave. Lists of questions issued for voluntary practise – teachers will mark and discuss how to improve these. Extra help by appointment with English staff members. Revision materials available on Fronter/school website for both Language and Literature. Revision guides have been made available to buy. Targeted support from data analysis. “How to revise” and “planning skills” programme available from April. Controlled Assessment analysis in class related to marks needed to achieve target grades. Staff organised booster sessions connected to exam performance targeting underachievement. Examples of Marked exams for Unit 1 on system for re-take students: A and C grade standard. | Maths | <p>Revision classes are currently in place for module 2 re-takes. Revision sessions for module 3 will start in March. Targeted revision session will be available for: A* and A grade work, B grade – A grade work, C- D borderline and Improving to a D grade. NOTE: YOU MAY ATTEND ANY OF THE CLASSES AT YOUR APPROPRIATE LEVEL. YOU ARE NOT RESTRICTED TO THE SESSIONS OFFERED BY YOUR CLASS TEACHER. REVISION BOOKS AND WORK BOOKS ARE AVAILABLE TO BUY. | Geography | <p>The Geography department will be revising the key aspects of the course in lessons in the weeks before the exam. 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| MFL | <p>Booster - Tiered level booster sessions offered each week.
