To all our parents

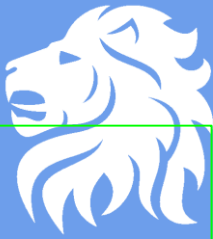


You have had to juggle work and family commitments with our detailed programme of home learning. Thank you for supporting us and your child.

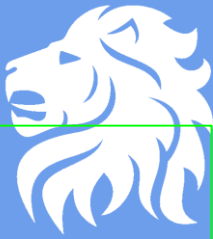
To our Cleaning Team

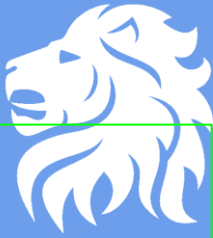
To our Pastoral Team

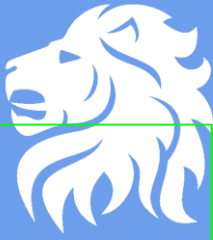

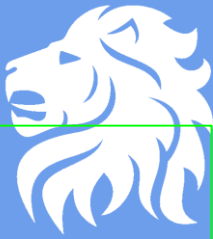
To our KDS Provision students

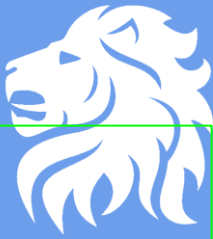
Our **HR Team** have offered expert advice and support to our staff during this period of Lockdown.

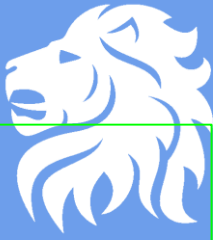
To our Exam Team
