

# The power of the Green Pen - Acting on Feedback

We ask all students to carry their green pen in every lesson, every day, and we need your support to reinforce this simple but vital routine.

The green pen is essential because it shows us that the student is acting on feedback received. When a teacher gives feedback—whether it's written guidance or a verbal correction—the student must use the green pen to fix misconceptions, complete correction tasks, or respond to questions. This process is critical for student improvement as it:

- Secures Understanding: It forces the student to re-engage with a concept they previously struggled with, ensuring the core knowledge is securely embedded.
- Drives Progress: It proves that they have actively engaged with the feedback, which is key to accelerating their overall progress.
