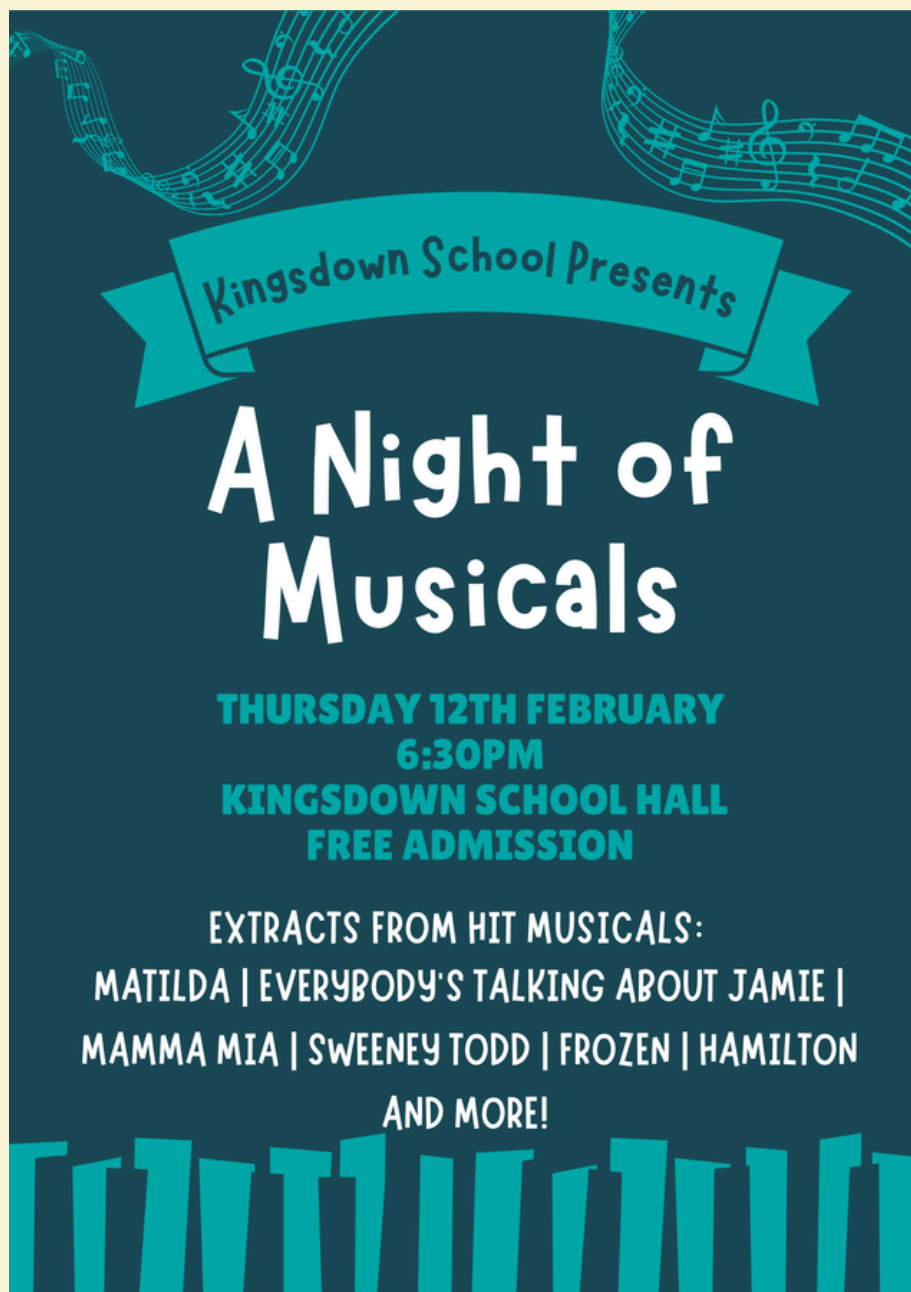
Holocaust Memorial Assemblies
