Black History Month

Last week students heard in assembly from Ms Green about Black History Month. They looked at why this month is important through Article 2 a right to non-discrimination. Ms Green also focused on the theme for this year which is "Standing firm in power and pride and gave examples of key figures in Black British history . Students were also able to go deeper through their votes for schools topic of. " Does fashion teach us about Black history?" Next week assemblies will have a focus on hate crime awareness and in particuar a disucssion on being anti-racist, with further tutor conversations around article 2 and article 30 which means children have the right to use their own language, culture and religion - even if these are not shared by most people in the country where they live, along with opportunities in tutor groups to explore these rights further.
