Safeguarding - Cyber bullying

Worried that your child has been receiving abusive or inappropriate messages? Below are some things that you can do:

- 1. Block the individual who is being abusive
- 2. Report the abuse to either the social media platform or to your mobile phone provider.
- 3. You can report the abuse online to CEOP

- 1. Report the incident to the police.
- 2. If your child has received sexual content do not email or send the image to anyone else. Report to the police immediately.
- 3. Report any concerns to via the SHARPs button on the Kingsdown website.

Supporting SMHW organisation



We are now setting the weekly tasks on a Friday for completion by the following Friday. This means that all tasks have the same completion date and it can be tricky to decide where to start.

Here are a few suggestions:

- Take a piece of paper and make a note of each homework and the type i.e. quiz, written
- Create a blank weekly timetable that suits the family to include when the computer will be available, breaks and family time
- Go through the list and write down on the timetable when the task will be completed and how long it is expected to take
- As each task is completed, cross out on the list and also submit on SMHW
- Agree a reward for completion and submission of tasks

Year 10 English: Spoken Language Endorsement

Over the next two weeks Year 10 will be completing their Spoken Language Endorsement. They will receive a certificate for this on results day in year 11 and will achieve a separate qualification of a pass/merit/distinction.

It is very important that students complete this as it is a separate qualification and when we return to school we complete the curriculums for the Literature and Language GCSEs. Therefore your support and help will be appreciated.

This qualification requires the following:

1. The student to research and write a speech about a topic of their choice. It must have an element of a debate.

2.To perform and record the speech on their phones. This may be called as the sample to the exam board, so must be audible and clear. They will then submit this to their class teacher.

3.To achieve a minimum of a pass, they must be asked at least three questions to which they need to respond in some detail.

All students have access to the English department website where weekly videos and audio files are provided to walk them through what to do each week.

Thank you for supporting your son/daughter through this aspect of their GCSEs.



From Monday 4th May, students will be able to gain rewards remotely. This will include:

- Achievement points for responding to tutor bulletin by 3pm each Monday (10 points)
- Gold cards for good work (25 points)
- Beats nominations (5 points) and awards (35 points), presented in a fortnightly virtual assembly
- End of year rewards day either in July or September for students with a positive points balance
