# **Further Student Leadership opportunities**

Applications are now open for **Year 9 and 10 students** if they wish to join the wider student leadership team of House and vice house captains, senior students and prefects. This application will close at **9am Monday 17th March**. Please encourage your child to think about one of these roles:

**Senior student council** - (stripy tie) to sit on a year council with a deputy head student, be part of leading peer education and leading duties at lunchtime and after school events, school tours etc. **Senior student press** - (stripy tie) to be part of the press team creating the student led school newspaper, be part of leading peer education and leading duties at lunchtime and after school events, school tours etc.

**House captain** - (stripy tie) to lead house assemblies and lead the pride meetings, be part of peer education and lead duties at lunchtime, after school events, school tours etc.

**Vice House captain** - (blue tie) to support house assemblies, be part of pride meetings, help with peer education and undertake a duty at lunchtime, support after school events, tours etc.
