Uniform message

It is essential that your child takes responsibility for wearing their uniform with pride. Thank you for ensuring that your child has the correct uniform this includes:

- Black socks
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms (PE uniform) with no branding
- Black polishable shoes
- No acrylic nails or nail polish (Need to be removed by Monday 8th Jan)
- No false eyelashes (Need to be removed by Monday 8th Jan)
- No hoodies
- Only one stud earring in the lower lobe and no hoops
- No nose piercings, including clear studs or bars

Students in the incorrect uniform will be sent to student services to support them in rectifying this. Please note that they must hand over their phone before a uniform is issued. Please do contact your tutor if you have any questions or you need support with anything. Can we please ask that you check your child's timetable the night before school so that they can prepare the correct uniform, school/PE and help them pack their bags with the items needed for the following day.

Lockdown

Schools' Football Week (week commencing 5th February)

On the week commencing 5th February, Kingsdown will be participating in Schools' Football Week, an English Schools Football Association scheme. This is an ongoing initiative designed as an opportunity for schools, teams and clubs from across the country to embrace schools' football and the wellbeing benefits it provides to pupils and players. It celebrates the importance of schools' football, competitive or otherwise, to pupils across England and provides an opportunity for staff to further discuss the benefits of schools' football within their educational environment.

There are further benefits for participating in this initiative for students at Kingsdown, including:

- Building interest to the The 2024 UEFA European Football Championship
- Promoting and growing girls football at Kingsdown
- Positive impact on the whole school community, linking to the Kingsdown 'responsibility' BEAT.
- 'Oddballs' charity provides a lecture to male Key Stage 4 students about testicular cancer.

This is an exciting opportunity, and will include the following changes to the normal school week at Kingsdown:

- A change to the CORE PE curriculum where every lesson will become an inter house football tournament
- Friday 9th February will be a non-uniform day. We would like students to wear a football shirt of their choice (or any sports shirt/sportswear if they don't have a football shirt), donating up to £1. Proceedings will be donated to the Mayor's Charity/Oddballs Charity.
- Whole schools activities, including a Lunchtime Crossbar challenge, a penalty shoot out and a Tutor time football quiz .
