Attendance

The whole school attendance year to date is currently 96.1% which is very pleasing. Good attendance has a significant impact upon your child's progress. Please keep sending your child into school each and every day and on time for an 8.30am start.

Thank you for ensuring that your child attends school every day. A reminder that if your child's attendance falls below 90% they are automatically classed as Persistent Absentees. You will then be contacted to see how we can work together to support your child in attending.

Safeguarding - reinforcing an important message about playing football with your child

We are aware of a current tik tok trend where students are tackling each other whilst playing football in a deliberately dangerous manner. Please can you reinforce this message with your child by discouraging this dangerous action. These actions lead to very serious injuries to others and the severity of this type of tackle has no place in football or school. Thank you for your support here.

E-scooters - Safeguarding your child

E-scooters must not be used by our students as a form of transport to and from school. It is illegal to use E-scooters in public places. We have spoken to the local neighbourhood policing team, who have confirmed that the only legal place that you may use them within Wiltshire is on private land with the owner's consent. The Police have said they have and will be seizing e-scooters and those found using them could be liable to receive points on their driving licence. For those who are yet to get a licence these points can be added retrospectively. Therefore, should anyone arrive at school with an e-scooter, parents/carers will be called to come and collect it at the end of the day.
