### Non- Uniform Day - Sports Relief - 13<sup>th</sup> March 2020

This Friday Sports Relief events are happening across the country to inspire the nation through the power of sport. There will be a number of small-scale events taking place in school tomorrow that have been organised by our PE department. As part of these events, we will be having a non-uniform day on **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2020**. We have decided to split the money raised between Sports Relief and local charities. This year we are supporting the Mayor of Swindon's Charities, they are:

- Children's Cancer and Leukaemia Movement (CALM)
- Swindon and North Wiltshire Deaf Children's Society
