Supporting your child in the classroom at Kingsdown School

The following slides show the 'Essential 8' strategies that are used in each and every classroom at Kingsdown School. These strategies support the delivery of our curriculum and ensure that our students are working hard to maximise their progress and potential.

The effect of these strategies is clearly showing improved results. Students are able to learn and achieve in a safe, calm and productive atmosphere resulting in students being stretched, challenged and ambitious for their learning.

DNA

- **The starting activity for each and every lesson**
 - The task you get involved in as soon as you enter the room
 - This is testing you on knowledge you have covered before.

Silent Solo

- **A section of the lesson where you will have to work on your own and in silence**
 - This will happen once the task has been explained and modelled to you
 - You **MUST** work silently to focus fully on the task
 - Your opportunity to apply your knowledge

Tracking not watching

- **The teacher will circulate the room looking at everyone's work and checking for common errors.**
 - You make sure you get on with the task straight away
 - Teachers will feedback to you quickly

Cold Call

- **The teacher will pick people to answer the question once the whole class has been given thinking time**
 - When the class has been asked a question, be prepared to give an answer.

No Opt Out

- **Once a question has been asked and you have been picked to answer, you must give a response**
 - You must be ready to give an answer
 - If you aren't sure, you still must try. No 'I don't know'

Right is Right

- **Questions are answered in full sentences using the right terminology**
 - This helps us give more detailed answers and practice using the correct words

Show Call


- **Students work is displayed to the class using a visualizer. The teacher will talk through it**
 - This will help all students improve work, correct common mistakes and give instant feedback
 - Students can instantly correct their own mistakes in green pen when a teacher has shown these improvements on the screen

SLANT

- Your behaviour expectations for inside the classroom

During Lessons:

S	<u>Sit up Straight</u> – We sit up at our desk, sitting correctly on our chair.
L	<u>Listen</u> – We listen to the information being given by the teacher and to those involved in the class discussion
A	<u>Answer Questions</u> – We answer all questions from the teacher, sharing our thoughts if we are unsure.
N	<u>Never Interrupt</u> – We allow the teacher and other students to make their point fully before adding our point of view.
T	<u>Track the Speaker</u> – We look at the speaker at all times, whether that be the teacher or another member of the class

Students have received intensive revision lessons and **must be carrying out their own revision plan at home.**

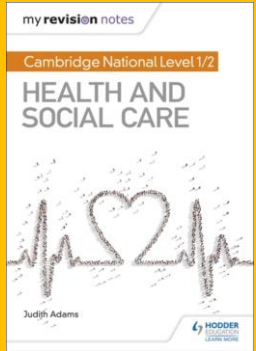
They have a revision list where they can tick off what they have learnt and practised.

Students need to **LEARN** all RO21 information **thoroughly** – they need to be able to **APPLY** it to context based

questions in the exam.

I would strongly recommend ALL students have a copy of the revision book – Cost £7.99 Amazon. →

This book is on the school website under the HSC tab if you do not want to buy it, but often a hard copy is preferable so that students can annotate. (ISBN – 978-1-5104-2945-1 Hodder Education)



The exam paper is 1 hour 15 mins and requires careful planning of answers. All students are aiming for a Merit Level 2 as a minimum target grade.

I will be running a revision session on Friday 3rd January 2020 (9am – 12) which I hope will be well attended by all.

Coursework – RO22 (Communication and working with individuals in HSC and EY settings) The deadline for this to be completed and handed in to me is **TUESDAY 17TH DECEMBER 2019**. It is being sent off on January 7th and I **must get it marked over the holiday**. There is no extension to this date at all and so please support your son / daughter to use their time wisely to meet this deadline with their best work. Thank you.

Expectations for the new year

All students will return to school on Tuesday 7th January at 8:30am.

A reminder to those cycling:

- Wear a helmet whilst riding to and from school
- Cycle without wearing headphones
- Ensure they dismount their bike at the top of the driveway and walk it to the storage
- Lock their bike and helmet securely in the storage area
- Service their bike regularly to ensure brakes/tyres are safe for road use
- Ensure bikes are fitted with lights in preparation for winter months
- Cycle sensibly on the journey, using cycle paths and on the correct side of the road, obeying the highway code
